Introduction

This report provides a summary of student enrollment, faculty headcount and status, as well as race and ethnicity, in PAB-accredited planning programs. The data is based on the 2013 Annual Reports, which all accredited programs are required to complete. Information provided in the Annual Reports is self-reported by each program.

As of December 31, 2013, PAB accredited 73 master's and 15 bachelor's programs at 77 North American universities. This report focuses on data for U.S. citizens and residents; therefore, the following non-U.S. institutions were excluded: University of Montreal and University of British Columbia. Student data is reported as of December 31, 2013. Faculty data is reported for the academic year 2013-2014.

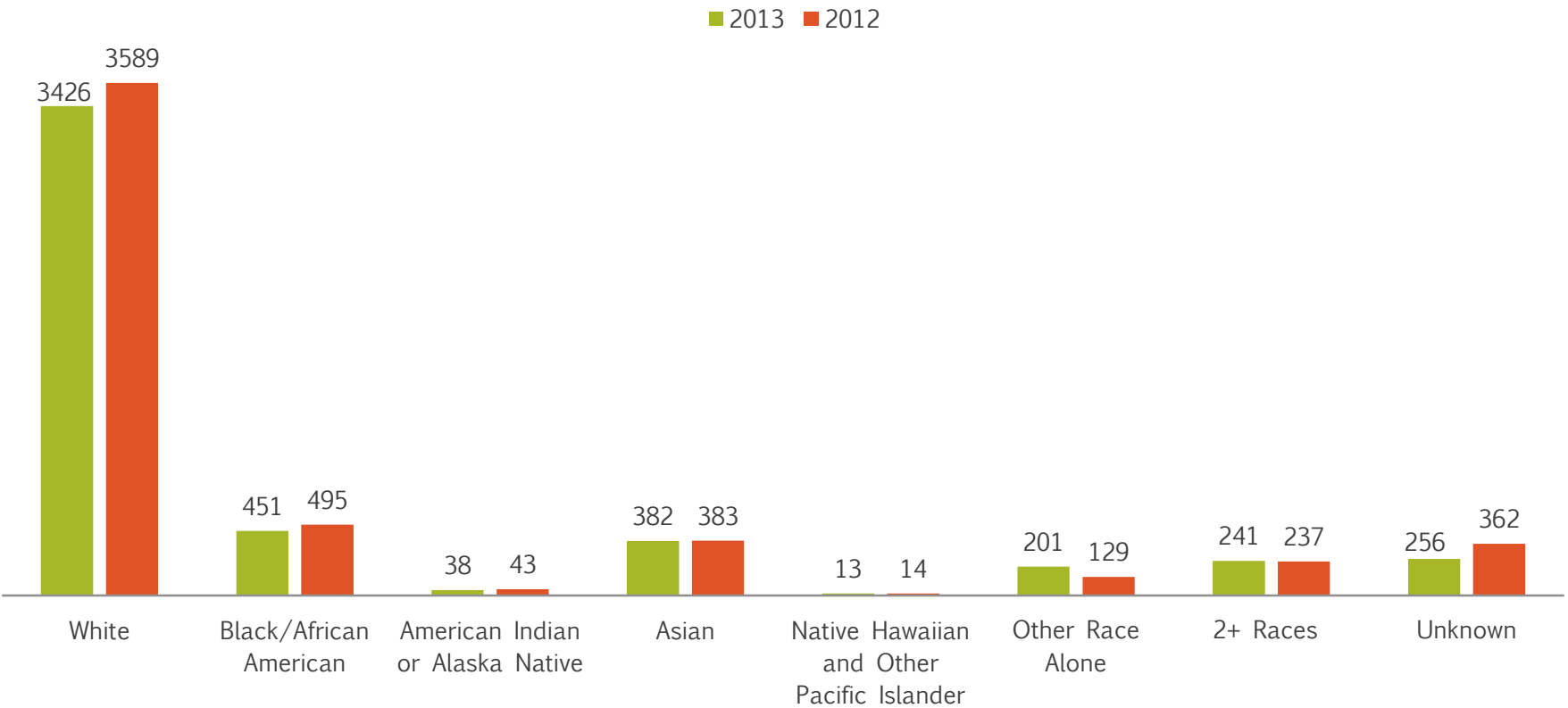
Figure 1.	Students Enrolled in PAB-accredited Programs: by Race	4

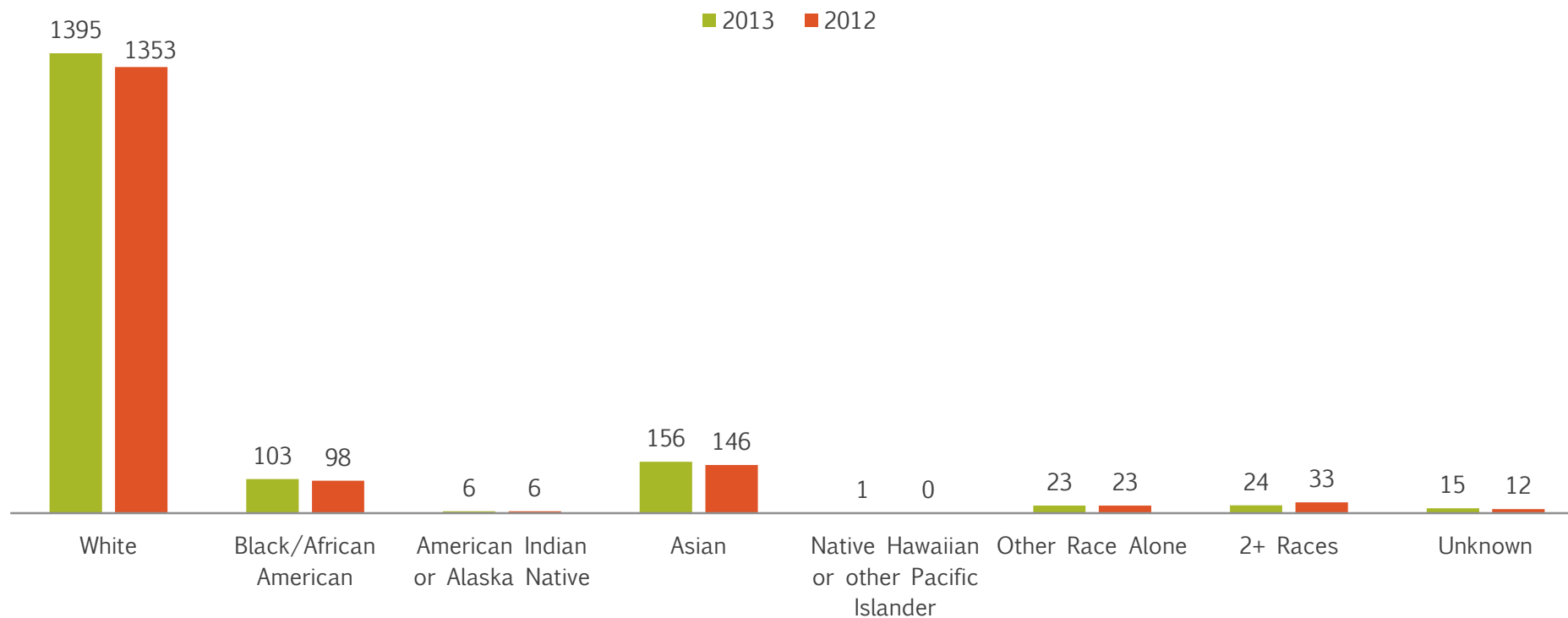
